1 Bond from Gideon Mathes to David Mathes for the penal sum of Four thousand Dollars Conditioned if the said David Mathes his heirs executors or administrators shall pay or cause to be paid unto the said Gideon Mathes his heirs and assigns the

sum of one hundred dollars annually for the term of Eleven years viz  
 one hundred dollars in one year from the fourteenth day of Dec<sup>r</sup> A.D 1825 With Interest after and so on for each succeeding year until the expiration of said Eleven years with interest after each of said annual payments become due Then the said Gideon Meathes binds himself his heirs and assigns to give and convey unto the said David Meathes his heirs executors Administrators or assigns a good valid and sufficient Warrantee Deed of about ninety acres of Land situate in Lee in the County of Strafford and State of New Hampshire Bounded Easterly by the road leading from Wadleighs School house by Benjamin Durgins to Federal Hill so called, in said Lee Northely by land formerly owned by Capt Josiah Bartlett and now by John Furber and Land of Peltrick Thompson West erty by Land of heirs of Jonathan Cartland to Land formerly owned by Moses Davis and now Land of mine the said Gideon Meathes whereon I now live thence easterly as the fence now stands to the road ofe said, With the buildings thereon be the same more or less, excepting and reserving the burying place in the corner of the orchard on said premises and a priviledge of passing and repassing across said premises by and on the usual traveled passway across the same.
