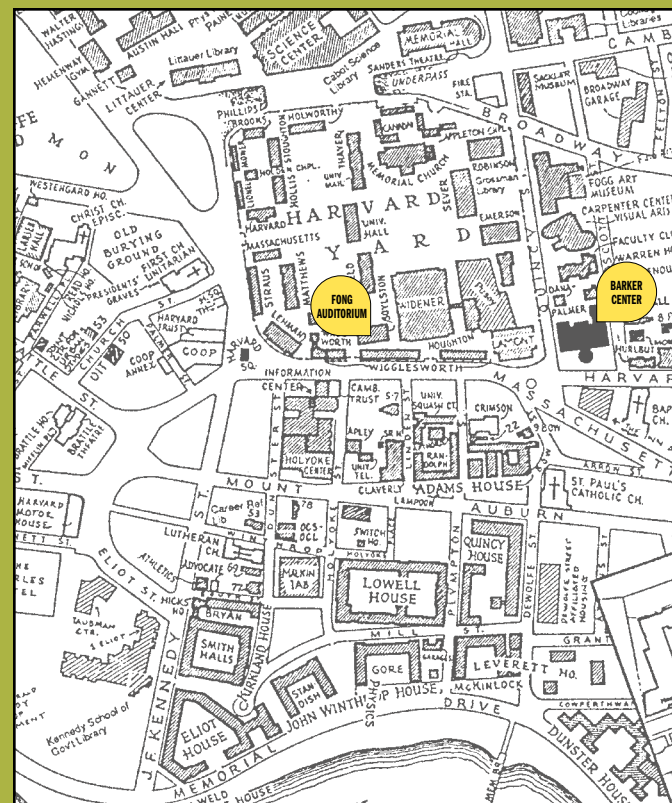
Travel and Accommodations
